WHAT IS DOUBLES KUMITE?

Doubles Kumite is an innovative and fun event that is very popular within the Philippines. In this event, a player who cannot excel individually may win due to developed tactics and teamwork. We find that many really love this event!

Rule 1

- a. A double is composed of two athletes of the same age category.
- b. Any player can score against anyone of the two opponents.
- c. Two players may attack a single opponent who has isolated themselves.
- d. A player may score on both opponents.
- e. Doubles kumite may only be used in Kumite events.
- f. With exception of the above rules, all other WKF kumite rules apply.

Skills developed in Doubles Kumite:

- a. Teamwork wherein one player may enhance the skill of his partner.
- b. Awareness of surroundings while engaged in mass attack.
- c. Development of new tactics and strategies for multiple opponents.

VII. Entries

- To ensure accuracy and speed, registrations will be entered electronically, online. All entries MUST use this method. No offline entries are allowed.
- A maximum of 500 player entries will be allowed.
- Every entry **must** be submitted by the deadline stated above.
- Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Any entries after the deadline will result in forfeiture of coach rebate, and may be refused.
- VIII. Waiver of Liability All participants must sign a waiver of liability before participation in any event will be allowed.
- IX. Tournament Rules and Regulations

WKF Rules of Competition will be strictly implemented along with those extra precautionary rules agreed upon during the Team Leaders meeting.

The person(s) in charge of submitted entries confirm that all competitors have been advised of the risk of kumite competitions and that they fully realize and accept these risks.

- Safety Equipment and Supplies
 All participants must provide for their own medical expenses / insurance.
- 1. All Kumite participants must use gum shields (mouth guard).
- 2. All players, 13 years of age or below, must wear head protection per new WKF rules.
- 3. Women Kumite players may use approved body protector.
- 4. All kumite players must use approved blue and red shin/instep guards.
- 5. Only approved red and blue mitts and red and blue belts may be used.
- 6. The Organizing Committee must first approve all body protectors before they can be used.

XI. Tournament Officials

Only qualified Referees and Judges recommended by participating clubs/organizations may officiate. (Please attach list of Referees and Qualifications)

XII.	Accommodations	We recommend booking via airbnb (<u>www.airbnb.com</u>). For location, just use Binan, Laguna and you can choose a variety of condominiums and apartments that are very affordable and within travel distance to the competition area.	
XIII.	Other Expenses	Airfare, hotel accommodations, food, medical and other incidental expenses are to be shouldered by the participating clubs/organizations or individuals.	
XIV.	Participation Fee	 International Fee: \$50.00 USD total, per participant, for both tournament and seminar. The coach gets a \$10.00 USD rebate per entry. National Fee (Philippines) 1,500php for 1 event with training seminar, per person. The coach gets 200php rebate per entry. 2,000php for 2 events with training seminar, per person. The coach gets 300php per entry. 200php for each additional event, per person. Any entries after the deadline will result in forfeiture of coach rebate, and may be refused.

XVI.	Drawings/Pairings	Drawings will be done via computer using a random seed. All competitors must provide proof of age with photo copy of an official government document.	
XVII.	Weigh-in	All weight category kumite participants must weigh-in on the day of the competition, at the venue, by the authorized Event Officials, before the tournament.	
XVIII.	Awarding Ceremony	Each tournament date is to be culminated by awarding ceremonies for al events of the day. Winners must attend the awarding ceremonies in proper attire (white karate uniform with belt, no shoes) to receive their awards <u>or they forfeit their awards</u> . No proxies allowed.	
XIX.	Deadline	All requirements must be submitted and received by the Organizing Committee on or before their respective deadlines. Entries must be submitted on or before February 23, 2018. Any entries after the deadline will result in forfeiture of coach rebate, and my be refused.
