Chapter 6 Registration Fees and Annual Fees

Article 6-3 Branch registration fees:

Annual fee: JPY10,000

Deadline of payment: Date of Overseas Kata Seminar (August 15)

Article 6-4

Branch registration shall have a term of 3 years and shall remain valid for that period of time. However, if the registration fee payment is in default for 3 consecutive years, branch registration shall be automatically canceled. In the event of such cancellation, all Dan promotion awarded by the headquarters to that branch will be withdrawn.

Special Attention:

- 1) Players must be registered as a member of JKF Gojukai and already paid Year 2024 membership fee.
- 2) All players must wear JKF/Gojukai officially-certified Jacket at competition.
- 3) All players must use special safety equipment.
- 4) All players use own red/blue color belt (Obi).
- 5) 1 supervisor and max. 5 coaches per branch are allowed.
- 6) Branch (Nation) name bib should be prepared by participant and be attached on the front (left side) of the jacket.
- 7) The player's number bib must be sealed on the backside of the jacket.
- 8) When a country sends 2 teams for Team Kumite, character A and B must be added to the nation's name (Example; England A and England B).
- 9) Only the first-aid treatment will be given for injured players while matching. Insurance will be covered to the accident happened during the tournament.
